6. nov. 2020	Udrejse	Afrejse fra CPH til Addis Ababa
7. nov. 2020	Addis Ababa- Sululta—Debra libanose –Addis Ababa	Day excursion to Debra Libanose Gorge via Sululta Plains which have a large number of wintering Pale arctic passerines and a variety of Afro-tropical species including the endemic Black-headed (Abyssinian) Siskin, White-billed Starling, Ruppell's Black Chat, Lanner Falcon, Verreaux's and Tawny Eagle. The Egyptian and White-backed Vultures, Lammergeyer, Erckel's Francolin, Rufous-breasted Sparrow hawk, Little and Common Rock Thrush, Red-collared Widowbird, Abyssinian Woodpecker, White-backed Black Tit, White-winged Cliff Chat and Brown Woodland Warbler are among the species we may see. The beautiful endemic Gelada Baboon is one of the highlights seen at the edge of Debra Libanose gorge Hotel: NEXUS HOTEL, Addis Ababa
8. nov. 2020	Debra Zeit – Cheleklaka- Awash NP	Leave Addis Ababa for Awash NP with en route birding at Cheleklaka of Debre zeit... then proceed to Awash NP. The thorny bush of Awash National park including the riverbank forest by the Awash River Falls is one of the best birding sites in the Ethiopian Rift valley. The Chestnut-bellied and Lichtenstein's Sandgrouse, Three-banded Courser, Orange-bellied Parrot, Steel-blue and Straw-tailed Whydah, Rosy-patched Shrike, Great Gray Shrike, Kori Bustard, Buff-crested and White bellied Bustards, Gray Wren-warbler, Green-winged Pytilia, Yellow-billed Hornbill, White-faced Scopes Owl, Pearl-spotted Owlet, Ruppell's and Black-headed Weavers, Swallow-tailed Kite, Bateleur, Lappet-faced and Egyptian Vultures, Shikra, Gabar Goshawk, Red-winged Bush-lark, Ashy Cisticola, Pygmy Sunbird, woodpeckers, Grey-headed Batis, and Somali Fiscal are among the birds inhabiting this wonderful low land. Moreover, the LAVA of Beseka lake is also home to the rare Sombre Rock chat. Hotel Awash Falls Lodge
9. nov 2020	Awash NP	Full day birding in and around the thorny bush of Awash NP..... immensely looking for the species listed in Day 2 ... Hotel – Awash Falls Lodge
10. nov 2020	Koka-Ziway- Lake Langan	Leave Awash NP for Lake Langano and en rout stopping at Koka Dam and Lake Ziway which is one of the best birding sites of the Ethiopian Rift Valley, and it provides species like the Lesser Jacana, Common Snipe, Black Heron(the Umbrella bird), Black crowned Crane, Saddle billed Stork, different Kingfishers, Great black-headed Gull and Lesser Moorhen. The Langano woodland with its lake side provides many birds like the Black-cheeked and Common Waxbills, Abyssinian Black Wheatear, Diederik and Klaas's Cuckoos, Boran and Rattling Cisticolas, Red-billed and Von der Decken's Hornbills, Banded Barbet, Spotted Eagle-owl, Red-headed Weaver, African Pygmy

		Kingfisher, Nubian and Bearded Woodpeckers, Brubru, Grey Flycatcher, Northern Black Tit, Hemprich's Hornbill and others. Hotel – ikke afklaret
11. nov. 2020	Bale Mts	Continue to Bale Mountains with a birding stop at Dinsho HQ. Here the endemic mammals like the elegant Mountain Nyala and Menelik's Bushbuck in addition to birds Abyssinian Ground Thrush, Abyssinian woodpecker, Abyssinian catbird, White backed Black tit, Spot breasted plover, Red breasted Sparrow hawk, Abyssinian Eagle Owl, Wood Owl and other higher altitude species. Then, proceed to Goba. Hotel: Goba Wabe Shebelle
12. nov. 2020	Sanattie/Bale	Today we will have a full day of birding in the forests near Goba and on Sanattie Plateau. Sanattie is the largest moorland tract in the whole of Africa. Abyssinian Woodpecker, Abyssinian Catbird, White-backed Black Tit, Abyssinian Ground Thrush, Yellow-crowned Canary, Somali Chestnut-winged Starling, Olive Pigeon, Mountain Buzzard, African Snipe, Thekla Lark, Malachite Sunbird, Mottled and Alpine Swifts, Moorland Francolin, Golden Eagle, Lanner Falcon, Wattled Crane are one of the highlights. Cinnamon Bracken Warbler, Ruddy Shelduck, Verreaux's' Eagle, Yellow-bellied and Common Waxbills, Tropical Boubou, Rufous-breasted Sparrow hawk, Abyssinian Slaty Flycatcher, Black-winged Lovebird and Bale Parisoma and Slender-billed Starlings are among the interesting birds of the Bale Mountains National Park. The beautiful <a href="#">Ethiopian Wolf (endemic)</a> , <a href="#">Abyssinian Hare</a> , <a href="#">Klipspringer</a> , <a href="#">Giant Mole Rat</a> , and different species of grass rats are some of the mammals that we expect in this magnificent moorland region. Moreover, Harrenna Forest, which is home to the localized endemic of Bale Monkey (if lucky), likewise forest bird species like African Crowned Eagle, Ayre's Hawk Eagle, Mountain Buzzard .... then return to Goba Hotel: Goba Wabe Shebelle
13. nov. 2020	Wondo Genet	Leave Goba for Wondo Genet home to the endemic species like the beautiful Yellow- fronted Parrot, Abyssinian wood Pecker and Banded Barbet. Apart from the endemic species, the forests produce an excellent birds like Narina's Trogon, African hill Babbler, Crowned Eagle, Broad-billed Roller, Half-collared Kingfisher, and Abyssinian Ground Thrush, Grey cuckoo Shrike, Lemon Dove and Double-toothed Barbet. Hotel: Wondo Genet Resort
14. nov. 2020	Lake Hawassa	The short drive will take us today to Lake Hawassa, the smallest and shallowest lake of the Ethiopian Rift System. Today we may not make any special stops unless we see special things in order to get enough time in Hawassa this afternoon. The Heuglin's (White-browed) Robin Chat, Willow and Lesser Swamp-warblers, Red-breasted Wryneck, Woodland and Grey Kingfisher, Spotted Creeper, Painted Snipe, Purple Swamp hen, Western-banded Snake-eagle, Giant Kingfisher, African Thrush, Senegal Thick-knee, Greenshank, Black-headed Batis, Little and Spectacled Weavers, Red-shouldered Cuckoo shrike and beautiful sunbirds are among the most

		interesting birds inhabiting Lake Hawassa and the surrounding woodlands. Hotel: United Africa /Shebelle Hotel
15. nov. 2020	Abijata-Shalla-Addis Ababa	Drive back to Addis Ababa with en route birding stop at Abijata-Shalla Lakes with the HQ's compound Hotel: ikke afklaret endnu
