Forord:

Fra den 1. – 17. januar 2007 afholdt DOF-Travel sin fjerde stortur til den lille indiske delstat Goa. Turen var tilrettelagt i samarbejde med My-Travel grupperejser, der sørgede for fly og hotelophold. Vi boede på Resort Lagoa Azul, der ligger ud til vådområder og marker i Little Baga.

Til de daglige ekskursioner benyttede vi den lokale chauffør og fugleguide Lloyd Fernandes, som vi har gode erfaringer med. Udover at transportere os rundt i sin 16 personers bus arrangerede Lloyd morgenmadsbuffet i det fri, hvilket betød, at vi kunne starte tidligt om morgenen ofte før solopgang.

Hjemmefra havde vi booket plads for to nætter i teltejren ”Backwoods Camp”, der ligger i udkanten af naturreservatet the Bhagwan Mahaveer Wildlife Sanctuary. Udover opholdet i ”Backwoods” arrangerede ”Backwoodsdrængene” (Leio, Loven og Pramod) en bådture på River Zuari med Collared Kingfisher som hovedattraktion.

Vejret i Goa er på denne årstid godt: skyfrit med en let til jævn vind. Temperaturen lå i dagstimerne omkring 30° de første 10 dage, siden steg den, og nåede et max. på 39° den 14. januar. Nat- og morgentemperaturene var noget lavere, og om morgenen var der oftest behov for både trøje og lange bukser.

Hermed en tak til samtlige deltagere for en uforglemmelig tur, der bød på mange store (fugle)oplevelser.

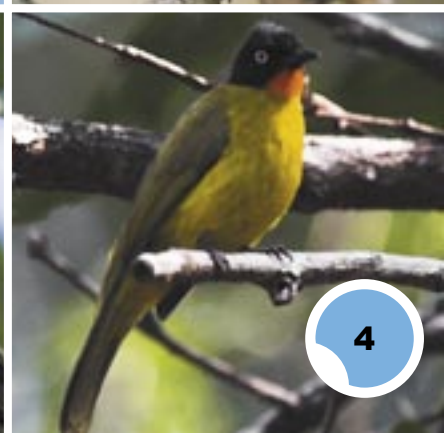
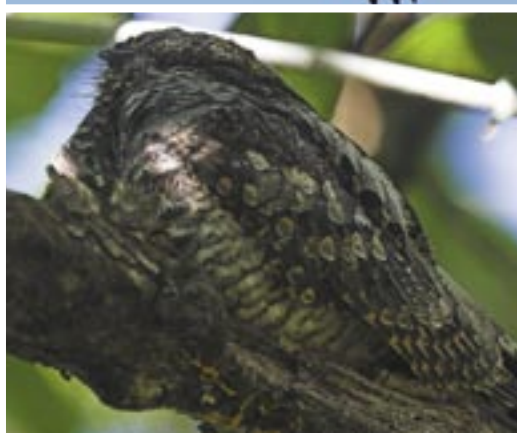
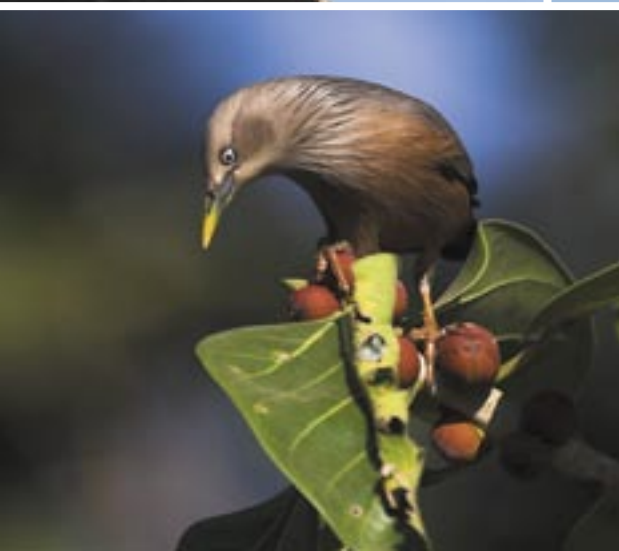
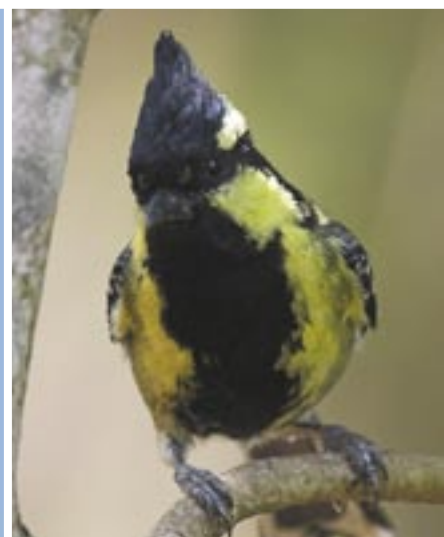
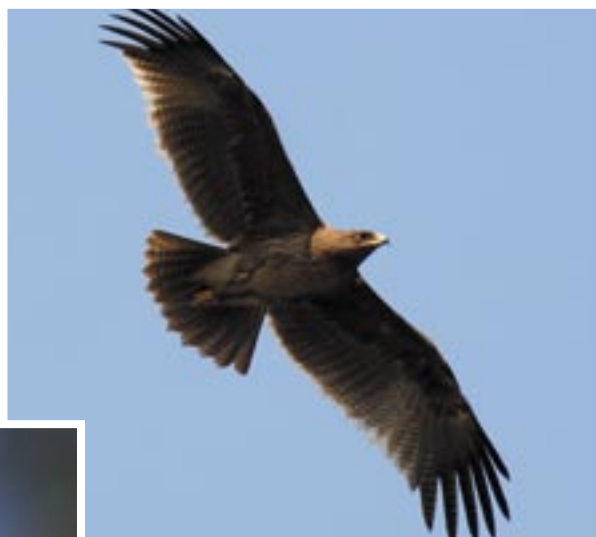

Mest opsigtsvækkende var to (et par) Røde Avadater, som desværre kun blev set af Carl Erik og Thomas samt hele 52 Terekklirer på højvandsrast. Dagen blev afsluttet på Divar Island, hvor vi så hele fem fine Steppehøge samt 1700 korttået lærker. Aftenen blev afsluttet med en god middag og en familie af Slørugler.

5. Januar 2007

Dag 3 – Dagen skulle først og fremmest byde på mågekiggeeri på Morjim Beach. Skuffelsen var stor da vi ved ankomsten til strande kunne konstatere, at alle mågerne fløj op ad floden. Der gik dog ikke lang tid, før en fin samling indeholdende alle sandsynlige måger, kom tilbage og stod på stranden. Ud over havet opdagede Kurt dagens hit: 2 Almindelige kjoever der jagede måger og terne langt til havs. Efter at have trampet hele 14 løbehøns op, gik vi på småfuglelusk i haver og krat indenfor stranden, hvilket gav mange fine småfugle. Særligt skal fremhæves Tickell's Blue Flycatcher og et par Indian Silverbill. Efter Morjim gik turen til Siolim, hvor alle håbede på Grey-headed Lapwing. Vi blev ikke skuffet, og desuden var vi vidner til et fint ørneshow med Crested Serpant Eagle, Stor Skrigeørn og Indisk Skrigeørn, der fløj rundt på nært hold. Ebbe var heldig, han så to Orientalske Braksvaler, som desværre fløj væk, og aldrig sås igen. Frokosten blev indtaget på en dejlig fiskerestaurant ved stranden i Anjuna. Her stod menuen på en yderst delikat fiskebuffet. Mens vi sad og dasede, drak kølige drinks og ventede på maden, så vi atter to Almindelige Kjoever - hvad sker der? Arten er meget sjælden i Indien - ikke mindst i Goa. Efter frokosten gik vi tur på Anjuna Fields, som kunne diske op med fine Mongolske Pibere og til vores overraskelse en Yellow-wattled Lapwing. På hjemvejen besøgte vi kort Apora Wood, som bød på et flot par Crimson Sunbirds. En helt fantastisk dag med mange overraskelser.

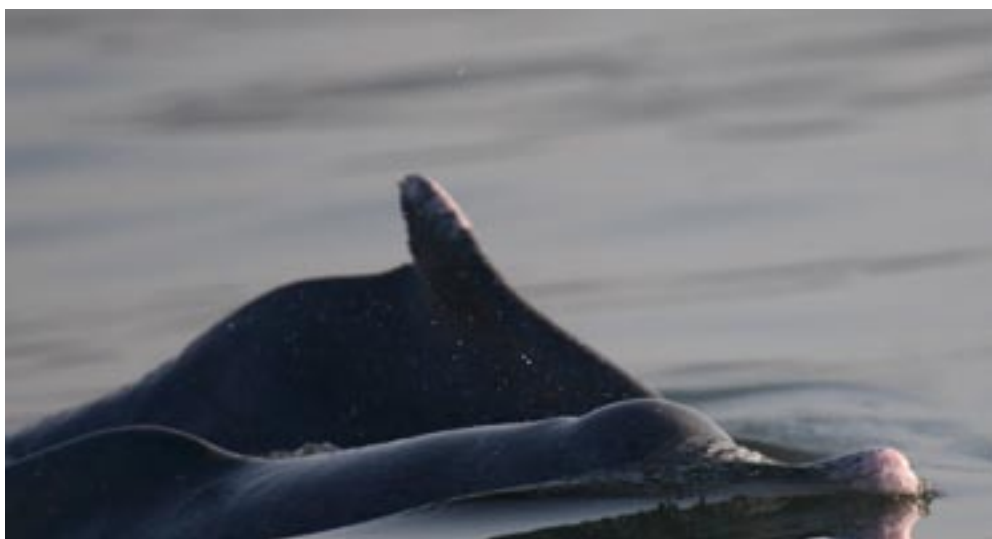
